### ○ Course Prerequisites

**TOEFL® iBT scores above 80 are required**

※The above-indicated English level of difficulty for the GRE® Perfect course is established at a level in which a native English-speaking instructor's lecture can be entirely comprehended.

### ○ Instruction hours

**Verbal: Once a week (3 hours) × 8 classes / Math: Once a week (3 hours) × 4 classes**

- Enrollment in the middle of a section is not permitted.
- Students are encouraged to take the Kaplan online GRE® diagnostic test. Access information for the Kaplan online resources will be emailed to students after application procedures are completed.
- Analytical Writing and Verbal Reasoning sections are covered during the Verbal section. Quantitative Reasoning section are covered in math section.

### ○ Tuition

**Verbal Section : ¥126,000    Math Section : ¥63,000    (Tax included)**

- Textbook fee is included in tuition (Textbook set contains all sections).
- First-time Kaplan Japan students will be charged a one-time enrollment fee of ¥26,250.
- Students who register for the GRE® Perfect course within one week of their trial lesson date will receive 5% off the tuition.

## ■ Course Registration Procedures

(1) One-on-one counseling	Individual consultations are designed to build the most suitable study plan, based on study goals, overseas study plans, TOEFL® and / or other English language test scores (if required), and time planned to devote to GRE® prep. The prospective student's understanding of what material is to be covered in the course is required prior to enrollment. Telephone consultations are available for prospective students who are unable to come to the center.
(2) Trial lesson	Trial lesson participation will be permitted after staff inquiry of the prospective student's English abilities, in the form of English education backgrounds, TOEFL® scores, etc. Demo lessons may be offered if the GRE® Perfect course is closed at the time of the prospective student's inquiry.
(3) Course registration	Students are required to complete the application form and sign/ date the enrollment agreement (back page of the application form) after carefully reading and agreeing to the terms of the agreement. Payment of the enrollment fee, tuition, and textbook fees is to be made within three days of submitting the application form.
(4) Course begins!	Students are required to bring their GRE® course book on the first day of class, and will be informed in advance of any assignments that are to be completed prior to the start of class.

## ■ GRE® Prep Course Q&A

### **Q: Please tell me more about the textbook and the instructor.**

A: A native English-speaking GRE® prep expert guides students through the twists and turns of the GRE® in a comprehensible and enjoyable English-speaking learning environment. The textbook set used in this course is also used in US Kaplan centers; however, the pace at which the course is conducted, as well as services offered, differs from that of US Kaplan centers. GRE® online learning tools offered in US Kaplan center courses are also offered. This center does not offer the Higher Score Guarantee.

### **Q: Are trial lessons offered?**

A: Yes, trial lessons are offered, after a consultation of the prospective student's test prep situation. If the GRE® Perfect course is closed at the time of the prospective student's inquiry, demo lessons may be offered, or the prospective student may be requested to wait until the next section of the GRE® Perfect course opens. Please see the course schedule (available on our website, or the "Kaplan Ochanomizu Test Prep Course Schedules"), or contact the staff for more information.

### **Q: Are make-up lessons available?**

A: Unfortunately, make-up lessons are not offered.

### **Q: Can students enroll in TOEFL® and GRE® courses at the same time?**

A: Yes. However, concurrent enrollment in TOEFL® and GRE® courses is recommended if the student's official TOEFL® score satisfies the approximate level of TOEFL® requirements for b-school admissions. The priority is to begin test prep and graduation school applications early. If the student does not meet the above requirements, customized proposals for test prep can be designed with the counselor; for example, beginning GRE® test prep with math. Please consult with the staff prior to enrollment.

### **Q: Are GRE® intensive courses offered?**

A: No. The only regular GRE® course currently offered is the GRE® Perfect course, which is offered once (or twice) a week, depending on the student's course application. Private lessons are available for students who require GRE® prep immediately before the test; however, please be aware that requests for private lessons may be declined, due to the instructor's availability. ### **Q: Does the Ochanomizu Center offer assistance when registering for the official GRE® test?**
